1. Present Cllrs Jonathan Molineux, Chris Bondi, Peter Roll & Jenny Davies. Clerk also in attendance.
2. Apologises; Cllr Barry & Mary Coleman, PCSO Paul Edwards
3. Declaration of interest - None
4. Minutes of previous meeting 7th July 2016 circulated with the correspondence prior to the meeting were agreed as correct signed by Cllrs Jonathan Molineux & Chris Bondi.
5. Matters arising; not covered later
  - a. Verge cutting at the junction of Thurne Road & B1152; Cllr Jonathan Molineux report this to NCC & along with many other similar complaints the verges were then cut.
6. Planning Applications - None
  - a. It was noted that the planning application for Hedra House has still not taken place now decision now expected late Sept. Cllrs Jonathan Molineux & Chris Bondi stayed they would possible attend.
7. Correspondence - only items discussed:
  - a. Centenary Plans CF from last meeting, no longer appropriate.
  - b. Norfolk Association of Local Councils have been in touch via e-mail & with Cllr Chris Bondi offering there services & advising of grants. Cllr Chris Bondi agreed to investigate further.

  - d. Current funds £22,882.52 including all fete takings
9. Playing Field & Staithe
  - a. Slipway collection tonight = £125.42
  - b. slipway box repainting; not yet completed. Ongoing
  - c. both playing field & staithe inspected recently & all in order
  - d. Cllr Jonathan Molineux is in regular contact with Enterprise Inns regarding the sale of The Lion & adjoining playing field no details currently known about the sale.
10. Thurne Toilets
  - a. Louise wages for August £310.00. This was approved & cheques signed by Cllrs Jonathan Molineux & Jenny Davies.
  - b. Louise reported all okay with the toilets.
  - c. Several comments have been received remarking on the improvement in the state of the cleanliness of the toilets. This to be passed onto Louise.
  - d. The rubbish nuisance also seems to be under control now the bin has been moved to a more suitable site, it is also emptied regularly.

## 11. Thurne Fete

a. Profit £1,686.89. After some discussion it was agreed to once again distribute this between the two village churches & the PC not to retain a third for the playing field. Cheques for £843.45 to Thurne Methodist Church & St Edmunds PCC approved & cheques signed by Cllrs Jonathan Molineux & Jenny Davies

b. Letter received from Jean Cooke resigning from the Fete Committee; clerk to write to Jean expressing there thanks for all her work with the fete over the years. After some discussion it was agreed to list 'Fete Committee' as an agenda item for the Annual Parish meeting in May 2017. Adverts alongside this to encourage new committee members to come forward.

a. Apart from uploading required documents there is currently no progress on web site. William should start the work in earnest in November.
